We provide a stimulating, social environment responsive to the needs of our clients. Respite and supportive care for caregivers are also services that we offer through personalized and professional care at a reasonable cost.

This is a great resource if you or your loved one are not safe to stay home alone while caregivers work during the day. The center is open 7:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. and is available Monday through Friday. All person-centered services are under the direction of medical staff, including an RN, LPN, and SRNAs. The center offers socialization, activities, nutritional meals and snacks, and medical services if directed by your physician. We strive to engage our clients into the community and bring the community into our center to enrich our program.

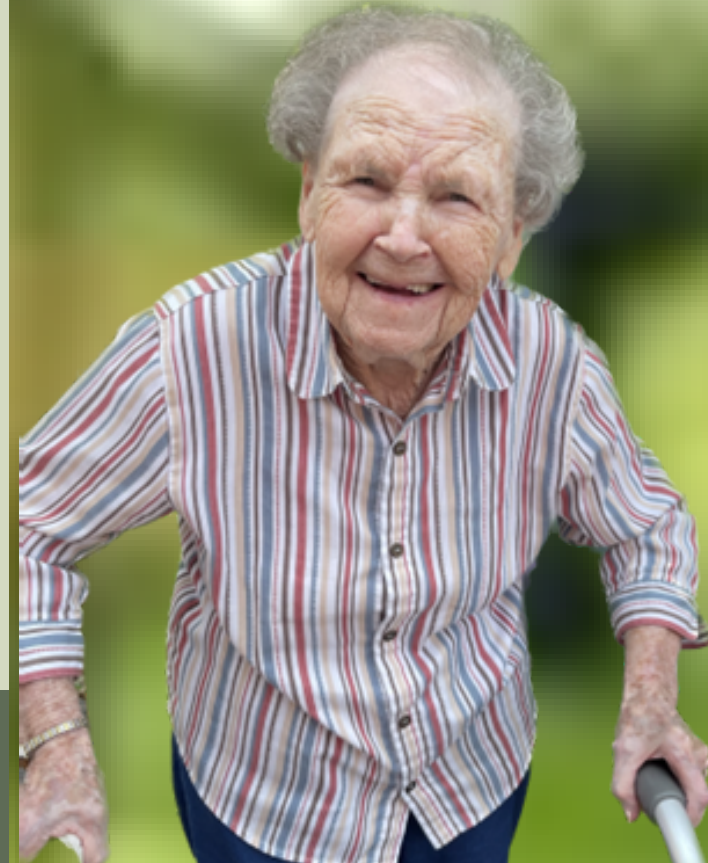

Leer. After Mr. Blanton presented this for consideration to the Bourbon County Fiscal Court, they formed the Bourbon County Public Properties Corporation, and both gentleman served on the board. The plot of ground to build the home was purchased from Mr. and Mrs. W.O. Crombie consisting of 5.83 acres for \$60,000 which was market price at that time. Several residents, still to this day, recall the Crombie farm. Bourbon Heights, Inc. has set the standard in long-term care by providing services that incorporate our history, values, and our promise for the seniors of this community to age gracefully, while maintaining their dignity and independence.
